We are committing **\$1 million** to support organizations helping provide critical medical equipment and supplies to regions around the world.

- **Project ECHO**: Our grant to Project ECHO will support their global work, in particular, efforts in [India](#) to help extend the capacity of the Ministry of Health to provide tele-medicine capability to remote locations and vulnerable populations.
